# POINTS FOR PRAYER

**ITALY** - Last Sunday, (8th) Alan and Tracey Johnston were commissioned by Coleraine and Limavady Presbytery for mission service in Italy. Alan, who was formerly the minister in Hazelbank Presbyterian Church in Coleraine will be taking up the role of Associate Pastor in the Sola Grazia Church, a church plant of Coram Deo Ministries.

They have three children, two of whom are young adults and will remain in N Ireland to further their studies. Their youngest son will be travelling to Italy in August to study an International Baccalaureate in Verona International School.

Over the next few weeks they will be setting up home and settling into life in Italy. Next week they will be involved in a Coram Deo Ministries conference in Tuscany.

**SPAIN** - Stephen Anderson has been invited by the Spanish Evangelical Church to take up the role of pastoral oversight for the congregation of Torre del Mar in southern Spain and to spearhead involvement in community development and outreach in the wider Torre del Mar area. Steve was accepted as a Candidate for mission service in Spain by the Board of Mission Overseas in March and is due to be commissioned by South Belfast Presbytery in Fitzroy Presbyterian Church, Belfast, this Sunday (15th). He is due to depart for Spain in early July.

- Pray that the Commissioning Service on Sunday will be a blessing and encouragement to Steve.
- Remember him over the next few weeks as he makes his final preparations before departing for Spain.

**NEPAL** - United Mission to Nepal (UMN) sends the following prayer requests:-
