**Moderator |** Use the words of Paul in Ephesians 3:17-19 as the basis of our prayers: 'Being rooted and grounded in love, may we have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God'.

**Worship: Desiring God's presence |** "Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you!" Isaiah 64:1. Ask for a real and meaningful sense of God's presence in worship today.
